

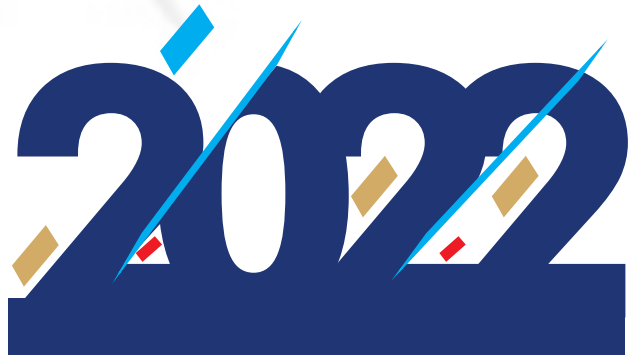
VICE-CHANCELLOR'S NEW YEAR MESSAGE (2022)
